



Huttoft Primary School (Academy) School Results 2016

We are very pleased to celebrate the successful achievements of all our children during the school year 2015/2016

11+ Data
(for admission to Year 7 September 2017)

62% of all the children in Year 6 qualified for a Grammar School place with a score of 220+ (National average = 25%)

11+ Data
(for admission to Year 7 in September 2016)

65% of all the children in Year 6 qualified for a Grammar School with a score of 220+ (National average = 25%)

- **EYFS** 43% of children achieved the 'Expected Level' of development
75% of children achieved the Prime Learning Goals
- **Year 1 Phonics Screening Check** 72% achieved 32+ marks
- A small number of children re-took the Phonics Screening Check in Year 2 and out of those 78% achieved 32+ marks
- **KS1 and KS2 Outcomes** In 2016, the new more challenging National Curriculum introduced in 2014, was assessed by new tests and interim frameworks for teacher assessment. Results are no longer reported as 'Levels'; each pupil receives their Test Results as a scaled score and teacher assessments based on their standard in the interim framework. Performance on the new measures is not comparable with 2015 performance.
