



## Huttoft Primary School (Academy) School Results 2017

We are very pleased to celebrate the successful achievements of all our children during the school year 2016/2017

### 11+ Data

(admitted to Year 7 September 2017)

65% of all the children in Year 6 qualified for a Grammar School place with a score of 220+  
(National average = 25 – 30%)

### 11+ Data

(for admission to Year 7 in September 2018)

62% of all the children in Year 6 qualified for a Grammar School with a score of 220+  
(National average = 25 – 30%)

- **EYFS** 78% of children achieved the 'Expected Level' of development  
82% of children achieved the Prime Learning Goals
- **Year 1 Phonics Screening Check** 84% achieved the threshold of 32+
- A small number of children re-took the Phonics Screening Check in Year 2 and out of those 75% achieved 32+ marks
- **KS1 and KS2 Outcomes** 2017 was the second year of Testing on the new, more challenging National Curriculum introduced in 2014. Results are no longer reported as 'Levels'; each pupil receives their Test and Teacher Assessment Results as scaled scores. Performance on these scaled scores is not comparable with the 'Levels' of 2015 and earlier.
