



Huttoft Primary School (Academy) School Results 2018

We are very pleased to celebrate the successful achievements of all our children during the school year 17/18

11+ Data

(admitted to Year 7 September 2018)

62% of all the children in Year 6 qualified for a Grammar School place with a score of 220+ (Lincolnshire average = 25% - 30%)

11+ Data

(for admission to Year 7 in September 2019)

67% of all the children in Year 6 qualified for a Grammar School with a score of 220+ (Lincolnshire average = 25% – 30%)

- **EYFS** 70% of children achieved a 'Good Level of Development' i.e., at least 'Expected' in the 3 Prime Areas and Literacy and Maths
88% of children achieved the 'Expected' Level in all of the Prime Areas of Learning
- **Year 1 Phonics Screening Check** 85% achieved the threshold of 32+
- A small number of children re-took the Phonics Screening Check in Year 2 and out of those 50% achieved 32+ marks
