- **School Uniform.....**the cut off date for on-line orders with Nationwide School Uniforms is Thursday 26th September for delivery to school on Tuesday 1st October. The Nationwide Uniform shop is at Vale Road, Spilsby, and they also have an on-line ordering system to your home. In addition, items of our uniform are still available via Trutex – visit Trutex.com
- **Swimming.....**at Club Tropicana resumes this Thursday, 12th September. There is no date as yet to when these sessions will finish but is anticipated it will be just before half term, we will let you have a date when we are informed.
- **PE kits.....**come home for washing this Friday. Please remember to return everything on Monday morning and take the opportunity to check your child's kit is clearly named – Thank you
- **Our weekly Class Trophy Awards.....**re-commence this Friday as Spelling Tests etc. get underway.

- **Aldi 'Kit for Schools'**.....is running up until 3rd November. We will be very pleased to receive your 'Team GB' stickers – either at the office or the children can put them in the collection box in the Y6 cloakroom area. Aldi issue a 'Team GB' sticker to shoppers spending £30 in store. We have a giant poster (with space for 300 stickers!) to fill, after which we can exchange it for school sports kit and start filling up a second poster.
- **'Tapestry'**.....is our on-line learning Journey record for each child in EYFS. Mrs Denton will be pleased to help any Nursery parents who feel unsure about how to use the system from home. Tapestry is such a convenient way to share your child's development with us and vice versa. It records right through to the end of Reception so Mrs Hobson will gladly help too.
- **On-line Safety teaching**...is provided specifically within our PSHE Scheme of Work from Y1 upwards in Weeks 1 and 7. Some advice from CEOP and the NSPCC about on-line safety at home you might like to consider includes: not having devices in children's bedrooms that access the internet; encouraging your child to ask an adult before they start watching videos on the internet; make use of the settings to tailor which videos/games/content is shown; encourage 'telling a trusted adult' if your child sees something on-line that makes them feel uncomfortable or upset; set time limits for using a device e.g. 25 mins and give a 5 min warning so the game etc. can be finished followed by a suggested activity for after 'device-time'.
- **Summer Uniform**.....may be worn right up to and including 30th September. Coats are not a requirement until the winter uniform comes in on 1st October. Huttoft Primary School gilets can be worn all year – they are available to purchase from the office.
- **Roald Dahl Day 2019**....will be celebrated at school on Thursday, 12th September. During the 'Day', each class will take part in two 'Drop Everything And Read' sessions. One when the teacher will read aloud from a Dahl text and the other, when the children will read their Reading Book to themselves. We will not be 'dressing up' - saving that excitement for World Book Day 2020 instead!
