- **Our Governing Body.....**is very committed to Music at school and ensures, through the Budget, that it is a high profile subject in our curriculum. The following activities enrich our music work and are all provided free of charge. Nursery children participate in a 6 week programme each Summer term led by Miss Briggs, one of the County music advisors; Nursery and Reception each participate in a weekly Singing Session for half a year led by Miss Witney, the County's singing advisor. Both Y3 and Y4 have a weekly 50 minute Whole Class Instrumental Teaching (WCIT) session led by Miss Briggs in which every child learns to play the violin or cello. Developing musical skills through learning to play an instrument can have a positive impact on organisational skills, co-ordination and self-expression across the curriculum.
- **Y4 and Y5 hockey session.....**with Glenn Kirkham, former England and Great Britain hockey captain! Glenn will be coming to school to share his skills on Thursday afternoon, 18<sup>th</sup> July – what a wonderful opportunity for the children.
