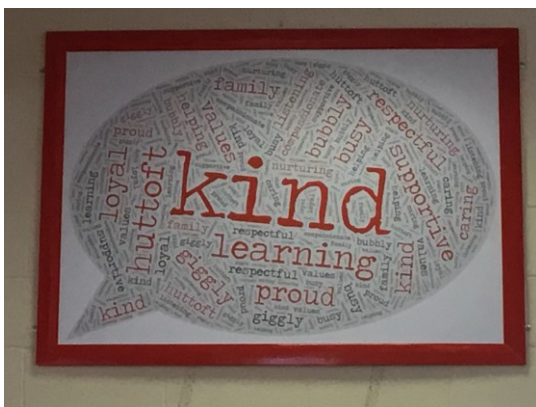


News Flier.....
