- **Nursery fees.....**just a reminder that with effect from June 3rd 2019 the fees for 2-3 year olds will rise to £5 per hour. This rise is necessary because of the high staffing ratios required for our youngest children. There is no change to the fees for 3-4 year olds. Please speak with Mrs Denton if you require clarity on our fee structure.
- **Applying for school transport.....**if you believe you are eligible for transport for your child you should apply on-line on the Lincolnshire County Council Website. This also applies to the children starting in Reception and Year 7 this September.
- **Instrumental music lessons....**resumed on Tuesday 23rd April. May I remind you that the £50 termly fee is now due in order for your child to receive their lesson.
