- **Our Book Fayre.....**is open to parents from 2:10pm – 2:40pm tomorrow, 14th March. My Storytime will be at 1:50pm. We will collect your children to join you for it and return them to class as the Book Fayre opens.

- **Weekly Golden Palm Swimming.....**at Chapel-St-Leonards resumes next Thursday - 21st March. The session time for pupils attending our school is from 'after school' up to 5:30pm. All children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times – he/she does not have to go in the water to do this, but must keep their child(ren) supervised. This activity costs £1 per child; monies go to school funds and are collected by one of our parents – usually Mrs Brabbs (Maisie Y3).
- **Year 6 Business Enterprise.....**this annual project is open for sales from Tuesday 19th March for about a week. The Year 6 children have been busy in their groups setting up their Businesses which are hand-made products, targeted for selling to younger children. Each class will be taken round the stalls on Tuesday and if you would like your child to purchase any of the products he or she will need between 50p to £2 to spend. Products include keyrings, fridge magnets, dream catchers, pom poms, squishies, mini cushions and bookmarks.
