"By joining the trust the children, teachers and their families will benefit from the collective skills, experience and resources of all of our schools."

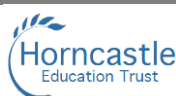
Headteacher Damian Davey added: "It's exactly what we need; it's a small trust with the same family values that we hold dear here at Huttoft.
