Plants: Plant Survival

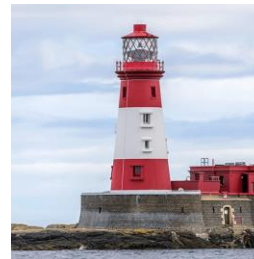
- Observing the growth of plants, recording changes over time and identifying what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

Uses of Everyday Materials

- Understanding the uses of everyday materials and how materials' properties make them suitable or unsuitable for specific purposes.

Mathematics

- **Measurement: Money** including counting money in pence and pounds, choosing notes and coins, making the same amount, comparing amounts of money, calculating with money, making a pound, finding change and solving two-step problems.
- **Number: Multiplication and Division** including recognising, making and adding equal groups, understanding multiplication sentences, using arrays, making equal groups through grouping and sharing, the 2, 10 and 5 times tables, dividing by 2, 10 and 5, doubling and halving and odd and even numbers.
- **Measurement: Length and Height** including measuring in cm and m, comparing and ordering lengths and heights and using the four operations with lengths and heights.
- **Measurement: Mass, Capacity and Temperature** including comparing mass, measuring in g, kg, ml and l, using the four operations with mass, volume and capacity, comparing volume and capacity, understanding temperature.

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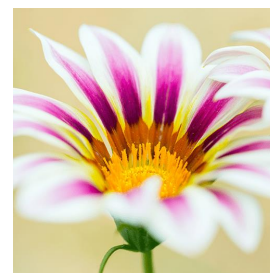
